What is SENPA?

SENPA is a group of talented photographers who are committed to helping conservation organisations.

We are volunteers, and SENPA is a not for profit group dedicated to supporting nature conservation.

How did SENPA form?

It has taken over 12 months to get together a committed group of enthusiasts who want to “give something back” to nature conservation through their photography. We have had to make sure that everyone is committed to the work they are involved in.

What does SENPA offer?

- Photographers who are experienced and skilled in photography.
- Are enthusiastic about nature photography and conservation.
- More importantly they want to work with nature conservation organisations.
- Co ordination of activities and a larger pool of individuals to help with promotional activities.
- Licences to use images are donated for free to conservation organisations in return for help in providing access to sites and knowledge to help photographers capture images and develop their understanding of subjects.
